The reference of a proper name is the object it means or indicates, whereas its sense is what the name expresses. The reference of a sentence is its truth value, whereas its sense is the thought that it expresses. Frege justified the distinction in a number of ways. Sen

General points of Gottlob Frege's Sense and Reference. Gottlob Frege begins by asking what identity is. Is it that which refers to the essence of a thing? If so, how is it being referred? The statements $a = b$ and $a = a$ can both refer to the same object (both a and b referring to a red ball for instance), but have according to Frege different cognitive values. Two signs can be used to reference the same object, so at least in this way their basic function is the same.
