Amer Fort or Amber Fort is a fort located in Amer, Rajasthan, India.Amer is a town with an area of 4 square kilometres (1.5 sq mi) located 11 kilometres (6.8 mi) from Jaipur, the capital of Rajasthan.The town of Amer and the Amber Fort were originally built by the Meenas, and later it was ruled by Raja Man Singh I.Located high on a hill, it is the principal tourist attraction in Jaipur.

Jaisalmer Fort is the second oldest fort in Rajasthan, built in 1156 AD by the Rajput Rawal (ruler) Jaisal from whom it derives its name, and stood at the crossroads of important trade routes (including the ancient Silk road)..
