The writer of the Gospel of John gives himself an odd nickname: "The Disciple Whom Jesus Loved.". In other translations, John refers to himself as the "Beloved Disciple.". The traditional view that the Beloved Disciple was the fisherman apostle John, one of the sons of Zebedee can be traced back as early as Irenaeus

(c. 180 CE) and was made part of the official Church History of Eusebius in the early 4th century. This identification, however “beloved” to so many, seems highly unlikely.

Though not directly stated, we know that John was called the beloved disciple, or “the disciple whom Jesus loved” (John 21:20-24). His occupation was as a fisherman before he and his brother became disciples of Christ. John and James were cousins to Jesus as their mother Salome was the sister of Jesus’ mother Mary (Matthew 27:56; Mark 15:40).
